The 2022 Skate Dallas competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the [current rulebook](#), as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating [website](#).

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and who are a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. Please refer to the current rulebook for non-U.S. Citizens.

### **COVID-19 EVENT POLICIES:**

As of March 15, 2022, and consistent with updated CDC guidance on mask use, face coverings are no longer required to be worn indoors at U.S. Figure Skating-sanctioned events or activity if your community levels are Low or Medium. We do encourage masks to be worn indoors if your community is in the High category based on the [CDC Community Levels by County Map](#) as announced on Feb. 25. Sanctioned activities include competitions (U.S. Figure Skating and Compete USA), exhibitions/performances and test sessions.

### **Series Information:**

**Skate Dallas 2022 is approved by U.S. Figure Skating as part of the 2022 Excel series.**

### **Skate Dallas 2022 is a qualifying events for the Adult Competition Series.**

Adult 1-6, adult beginner, adult high beginner, adult pre-bronze and adult bronze program/free skate events that meet Adult Competition Series guidelines are offered at this competition. Adult Competition Series participants must submit a photo, scanned copy, email attachment or screenshot of the results sheet to [adultcompetitionseries@gmail.com](mailto:adultcompetitionseries@gmail.com) by the deadline published in the most recent [Adult Competition Series Handbook](#) to receive credit and series points.

### **ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:**

**Test Level:** Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline in the discipline the skater is entering. Athletes may skate up one level, and may not skate down in any event."

**Age restrictions/requirements:** Singles free skate events (well-balanced program) have the following requirements:  
Open Pre-Juvenile: Girls – 13 years or older; Boys – 14 years or older  
Pre-Juvenile: Girls – 12 years or younger; Boys – 13 years or younger  
Juvenile: Girls – 12 years or younger; Boys – 13 years or younger  
Open Juvenile: Girls – 13 years or older; Boys – 14 years or older  
Intermediate must be under the age of 18  
Adults must be 21 years or older

Skaters entering pre-juvenile and lower events will be divided as closely as possible by age should the number of entries warrant more than one group.

#### **ADULT EVENTS:**

Age classes for all free skate and showcase events:

- Young Adult: 18 years through 20 years
- Class I: 21 years through 35 years
- Class II: 36 years through 45 years
- Class III: 46 years through 55 years
- Class IV: 56 years through 65 years
- Class V: 66 years and older

All age classes may be divided or combined depending on the number of entries and at the discretion of the chief referee and/or the competition committee.

#### **COMPETITION ENTRY - EMS REGISTRATION:**

**Registration Deadline: 05/05/2022 at 11:59pm ET**

**Late Registration Deadline: 05/12/2022 at 11:59pm ET + \$35 Late Fee**

Entries will be limited, so register early. Entries are accepted via [EMS](#) with credit card only. Each transaction is subject to a 3% credit card fee.

Entries must be paid with a successful credit card transaction to be considered valid and **must be completed by May 5, 2022 11:59pm ET**. Late entries can be considered for acceptance at the discretion of the competition committee only if accompanied by a \$35 late fee.

#### **FOREIGN SKATERS:**

Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition ([click here for HOW TO](#)). This can be done by choosing the “Create Account(Non-Member)” option on the [Members Only](#) login page.

#### **PARTNERED EVENTS (PAIRS/DUETS):**

Only one partner will complete registration for the team in EMS. During the registration process, you will be asked to identify your partner and verify their test information. **The registered partner will be responsible for managing all aspects of the competition for the team including music/PPC upload, practice ice sales, etc.**

### **Mandatory Athletes:**

Athletes age 18+ as of the competition start date who will be competing on a team (i.e. synchro, dance, pairs, shadow dance, theatre, etc.) with at least one minor athlete must complete SafeSport training. \*

Minor Athletes who turn 18 midseason are encouraged to seek parental consent to take the online SafeSport training early to avoid any disruptions in their ability to participate as the training is required upon turning 18. The athlete will not be SafeSport compliant until they have completed the training and their Members Only portal reflects completion. Please email [safesport@usfigureskating.org](mailto:safesport@usfigureskating.org) for instructions or questions regarding parental consent.

### **REFUND POLICY:**

Entry fees will not be refunded after the deadline date, unless no competition exists or the event is canceled. **There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals.** The online processing fees are not refundable. Checks returned for non-sufficient funds and contested credit card charges will be issued a \$35 fee. Payment of the fee will be required before the skater is allowed to participate in practice ice or events.

There will be a \$35 fee for each change of event or level after the entry deadline date.

Full refunds, **minus the online processing fee**, are available if withdrawal is prior to the entry deadline.

**SCHEDULE:** Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time during the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available.

### **FACILITIES:**

Credit Union of Texas Event Center & Allen Community Ice Rink is located at 200 East Stacy Road, Allen, TX 75002. Both ice surfaces are 200' x 85' with rounded corners.

### **MUSIC:**

Competitors participating in events utilizing music are required to upload their music to [EMS](#) no later than **May 26, 2022 11:59pm ET**. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature and subject to a \$35 late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

***Online music submission is the ONLY acceptable method to submit program music.*** All competition music must be electronically submitted via the EMS Skater Portal through the Music & Program Content tab no later than the date noted in EMS (\$35 administrative fee will apply).

***All music must be uploaded by the deadline.***

The uploaded program music **MUST** conform to the following specifications:

- Programs per file: One (1) - Only one piece of competition program music (e.g. short program, free skate, showcase, etc.) per file is allowed.
- File Format: mp3 - The uploaded file music must be an mp3 file. Simply changing the file extension to "mp3" from another file format is not acceptable. MP3 is the only file format EMS will accept.

Bit Rate: 192 kbps or higher and Sample Rate 44,100 kHz. This will be verified by the music chair and they may request you upload a corrected file.

Leaders/Trailers: The Chief Music Coordinator requests that there be NO leader and NO trailer (the silence or “dead space” before and after the actual start and end of the program music) Leaders/Trailers may not exceed two (2) seconds. Excessive leaders and trailers may disrupt the playing of the music during competition.

### **Backup Music at Event (CDs)**

In addition to submitting the music online, ***all competitors/teams must also have at least one (1) backup copy of their competition music on CD, AT RINKSIDE. Electronic devices, such as phones, for playing music will NOT be accepted. Have a backup CD ready!*** CDs must meet the following requirements:

- In standard Audio CD format (Compact Disc Digital Audio). Other formats, including mp3 are NOT acceptable.
- Clearly marked with a permanent marker (e.g. Sharpie, do NOT use a label or tape) as follows: First Name, Last Name, (Club – Optional but requested), Event, Event Segment and Music Length (e.g. Jane Smith, Acme FSC, Novice Ladies, Free Skate, 3:10 or Synchro Team, Widget FSC, Preliminary, Free Skate, 1:59)
- Each CD may have only ONE (1) music track on it. In the case where a skater competes in both a short program/dance and a free skate/free dance, two (2) separate discs must be available. Any disc with more than one (1) track is NOT acceptable.
- Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds.
- Due to the compatibility and reliability reasons, music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable “CDRW” discs. ***PLEASE, no CD-RWs!!***

The Local Organizing Committee (“LOC”), competition officials, and volunteers exercise reasonable care when handling CDs. However, they are not responsible for damage to or loss of any CDs. The LOC is not responsible for CDs not picked up by the end of the competition. Those CDs will be destroyed.

### **Interruption in Music – U.S. Figure Skating Rule 1403**

If, after the competitor/team’s name has been called to compete, there is an issue with the downloaded music or CD provided at the event, the competitor will have up to 3 minutes to rectify the situation with a backup copy of the music on CD. After 3 minutes, the competitor/team will be considered withdrawn.

### **Administrative Fee for Incorrect Music or Failure to Upload Music**

The LOC may assess each competitor/team an **additional charge, up to \$35.00 per event segment**, to manually handle a team’s music, if the competitor/team: 1) fails to submit their music prior to the close of online music submission, 2) submits files that do not follow the specifications above, or 3) uploads the incorrect music for a given event segment (e.g. uploads short program music instead of the free skate). In the event the LOC decides to assess an administrative fee, the competitor/teams will not receive their credentials at registration until they pay the fee and turn in their music on CD, conforming to the requirements above.

### **Planned Program Content (PPC):**

Events judged with the **International Judging System (IJS)** require the submission of the Planned Program Content (**PPC**) form.

Competitors participating in IJS events are required to submit their PPC in [EMS](#) no later than **May 26, 2022 11:59pm ET**. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature in EMS and subject to a \$20 late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

## **LIABILITY:**

U.S. Figure Skating, Dallas Figure Skating Club, and Allen Event Center & Community Ice Rink accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in this competition. This is in accordance with Rule 1600 of the official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

## **ON-SITE REGISTRATION DESK:**

See the event site located at [www.skatedallas.org](http://www.skatedallas.org) for registration desk open hours. Registration will be open from one to two hours before the first event and run through the last event of the day. The registration desk is located just inside the south entrance in the Arena Lobby and will open 30 minutes before the first practice ice session. Please register promptly upon arrival. Please note that Registration will **no longer accept any CDs**. If the skater's music was not uploaded or the uploaded version is not correct, the skater will provide their CD to the Music person after their name has been called to skate and before they get into their starting position, and then collect the CD before exiting the ice. **Electronic devices, such as phones, for playing music will NOT be accepted.**

## **LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS:**

Locker rooms and changing areas will not be accessible during Skate Dallas 2022. Skaters should be prepared to dress off-site and arrive/depart from the arena ready (costumes, hair, make-up, etc.) in competition attire. Athletes will be provided with an area to put skates on but will not be permitted to change in public restrooms.

## **PRACTICE ICE:**

Practice Ice will be divided by level and skaters will be able to select/purchase those sessions appropriate for their entered events. Practice ice credit may be pre-purchased during registration online at the discounted price of \$15 for each 20 (twenty) minute session. Pre-paid practice ice is non-refundable and may not be sold to other skaters. Practice ice can only be purchased through [EMS](#) online or in person at the competition registration/PI desk. After the schedule is released online sessions will be sold for \$18 each session. Once the PI desk opens at the event, all remaining practice ice sessions will be sold for \$20 each session.

**Premium event day warmup ice (middle of the day)** will be scheduled if time permits and will be sold at the practice ice desk, in person, for \$20 for each 15-minute session and may be offered online after schedule is completed if space allows. **NO MUSIC WILL BE PLAYED ON PREMIUM ICE.**

**Standard Event Level OFFICIAL PRACTICES** (session where music is played, included with event fee) will be assigned on Thursday, June 9<sup>th</sup> or possibly Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup> if events begin on Thursday. Please plan your travel time to attend official practice day. The ability to play program music on other practice sessions will be on a first come-first serve basis as time permits and is NOT GUARANTEED.

**Compete USA Practice Ice** is not included with entry fee and is available for purchase separately. Compete USA practices will be held on Sunday, June 12<sup>th</sup> only. No music will be played on Compete USA & Special Olympics practice sessions.

**Only uploaded** music will be played on practice sessions. No CDs, phones, etc., will be accepted even if there is a problem with the uploaded music. Please verify all uploaded music BEFORE the Music upload deadline.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY:**

Professional award photos, action photos and videography will be available at the event provided by **MKT Photography**. Personal cameras will be permitted in the bleachers only and may not be plugged into arena outlets. Videotaping for personal profit is not allowed. **Note, per U.S. Figure Skating policy, photographing and/or recording of anyone other than your own skater is strictly prohibited.** Please refer to the Basic Ice Usage and Skater Etiquette Information document found in the Club Resource section of Member's Only.

## **AWARDS:**

Medals will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place winners in all events. Ribbons will be awarded to fifth and sixth place winners. Trophies will be awarded to Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior, and Senior final round winners if number of entries warrant and time permits for final rounds to be held. All awards will be presented off-ice at the photographer's stand following each event.

The **DEBBIE BLOUNT MEMORIAL TROPHY** will be awarded to the skater placing 1<sup>st</sup> in the Intermediate Ladies Final Round. This trophy is given in memory of Debbie Blount (adult skater, mother of competitor Gabbie Blount, and a dedicated Dallas FSC volunteer).

The **SPIRIT OF SKATE DALLAS AWARD** will be awarded to one skater in the Juvenile Ladies Final Round. The trophy is presented to the Juvenile level skater displaying the most potential through their music interpretation, performance, and musicality. It is the program upon completion; everyone would say, "I would love to see that program again!"

## **OFFICIAL NOTICES:**

Notices will be posted online in EMS and on [SkateDallas.org](http://SkateDallas.org). It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check frequently for any schedule changes and/or notices. Skaters are requested to arrive 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule will be posted prior to the competition.

## **TEST CREDIT:**

Skaters that meet the requirements for test credit may request preparation of a test credit form at registration. Delay in printing of forms may occur if not requested prior to skating your event. Forms must be picked up at the registration desk prior to the end of the competition. Submission of test credit form to USFSA is the responsibility of the skater upon return home in conjunction with their home club test chair. Cost for test credit form preparation is \$10. Additionally, IF athletes are skating up **TWO** levels, they are not eligible to receive test credit.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:**

To be a credentialed coach at a sanctioned nonqualifying competition, coaches must meet the compliance requirements listed below and verified by the U.S. Figure Skating. Coaches must be included within a skater's registration or updated through their EMS Skater Portal.

All coach compliance is verified via EMS and is connected to the U.S. Figure Skating database.

The compliance tab within EMS lists ALL individuals who were declared by skaters at the time of registration or through their EMS Skater Portals (also allows access to skater schedule, music/PPC preview etc.). The compliance requirements are tied to our database and are updated daily. Further, if a coach is non-compliant, they will receive system generated emails through the start of the competition. ### STANDARD EVENT LEVELS

#### EVENTS OFFERED AND ENTRY FEES:

Well Balanced Intermediate thru Senior will be a Combined Short Program and Freeskate event. Singles skaters may compete in **only one** Combined SP/Freeskate event and may also enter **1 separate** Short Program event for further experience. Final Rounds (performing the Free Skate program only) will be offered at the discretion of the chief referee if time permits and entries warrant for PrePreliminary thru Juvenile WB Freeskate events, and for Intermediate thru Senior WB Combined events based on initial round scores.

Critiques are available (reserved in advance for an extra fee of \$10) for well balanced Juvenile thru Senior Freeskate events only.

Final Rounds will **not** be offered for Excel Levels as restricted by the 2022 Excel Series Rules.

**\*Note** –Open PreJuvenile is not considered part of the standard competition levels but is offered based on past demand. For event requirements Open PreJuvenile = PreJuvenile (please refer to Eligibility section for Open PreJuvenile age requirements).

**EVENTS INCLUDE:** BASIC ELEMENTS, COMPULSORY ELEMENTS, BASIC PROGRAM, FREESKATE, SHOWCASE, Basic Skills SYNCHRONIZED SKATING, SPECIAL OLYMPIANS

The 2022 Skate Dallas Compete USA competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the current rulebook, as well as any pertinent updates which have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and who are a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. Please refer to the current rulebook for non-U.S. Citizens.

### **ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:**

To be eligible, skaters must be members of either the Compete USA Program and / or full members of U.S. Figure Skating. To be eligible, skaters must have submitted a membership application or be a member in good standing. Members of other organizations are eligible to compete but must be registered with the host Compete USA Program / Club or any other Compete USA Program / Club.

Eligibility will be based on skill level as of the closing date of entries. All Snowplow Sam and BASIC 1- 6 skaters must skate at highest level passed or one level higher, and **NO** official U.S. Figure Skating tests may have been passed including Moves in the Field, or individual dances.

For the Pre-FREESKATE thru FREESKATE 6, eligibility will be based only upon highest Compete USA Free Skate test level passed (Moves in the Field test will not determine skater's competitive level). Skaters may skate at highest level passed OR one level higher BUT not both levels in the same event during the competition.

The Special Olympics portion of this competition will be conducted in accordance with the Official U.S. Figure Skating Rule Book, the Special Olympics Winter Sports Rules, and the rules given in the announcement. The Special Olympian Competition is open to skaters 8 years or older who are receiving group or private instruction. Skaters must be registered as Special Olympians through the Special Olympics office.

## DALLAS FSC TRI-SWIZZLE SERIES:

The TriSwizzle Series is for skaters in Compete USA PROGRAM EVENTS where skaters accumulate points from their placement and group size in SNOWPLOW SAM – FREESKATE 6 & INTRODUCTORY FREE SKATE levels. **TriSwizzle Series events include: 2021 Bunny Hop, 2022 Love Bug Open & 2022 Skate Dallas.** Skaters must compete in all series competitions to be eligible. TRI-SWIZZLE Champions will be Announced July 2022.
